

## Kent State Graduate Credit Registration & Payment Deadlines

Please pay close attention to the deadlines for registration and payment.

**The cost for graduate credit registration is \$150.**

### Workshop Registration Forms and Payment:

Registration can be completed online prior to the conference or by submission of the payment and completed registration form at the conference. The registration form is accessible at this website in 3 formats: (1) a PDF which can be submitted digitally; (2) a Word doc with fillable text boxes; and (3) a printable PDF to be completed by hand and submitted by mail or at the conference.

### Pre-Conference Registration and Payment:

You may preregister online using either your checking or savings account or by credit card (2.9% service fee). The deadline for pre-conference registration is **March 15, 2017**. ### Registration & Payment at the NEOTech Conference:

There will be a table for graduate credit registration located near the Welcome/Conference Check-In area near the entrance of the Kent State Student Center Ballroom (2<sup>nd</sup> floor). If you are paying by check your registration form along with payment need to be received by **1:00 p.m.** the day of the conference **March 16, 2017**.

### Kent State Graduate Credit Workshop Requirements:

In order to earn the one graduate credit hour you are required to complete the following:

1. Attend the one-day NEOTech Conference held at Kent State University on **March 16, 2017**.
2. Review the post-conference materials & resources at the NEOTech Post-Conference Workshop Google Site. The URL to the site will be provided in a confirmation email following registration and will also be provided at the conference.
3. Create and submit a lesson that incorporates tools, strategies, and/or approaches that were highlighted at the NEOTech conference and/or in the Google Site online resources.

All workshop registrants will meet briefly at the conclusion of the conference on March 16, 2017 at 3:45pm in the KSU Ballroom. We will go over workshop requirements and provide the workshop website and instructions to submit final projects. All other required work following the conference will be done online in the *Graduate Credit Workshop Google Site* and will be due no later than **12 a.m. April 23, 2017**.
